



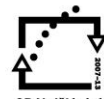

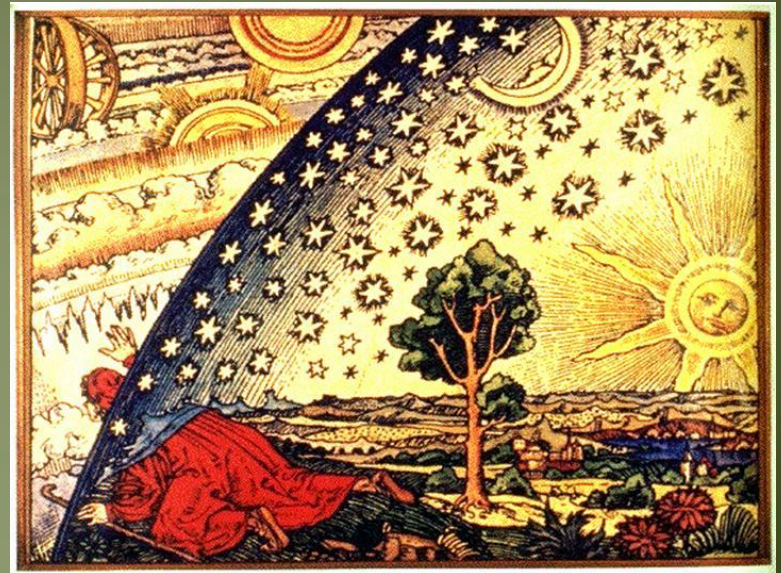

Making questions



Making questions

- There are two types of making questions in the past simple tense:

The verb **to be**

We only change the position of the verb and the subject

You were at home yesterday.



Were you at home yesterday?

All other verbs

We need the auxiliary verb **do** in its past form

You **studied** yesterday.

Did you study yesterday?



Making questions

- For questions in the past simple tense we need the auxiliary verb „to do“ in its past form -> **did**

Did + subject + verb + objects, adverbs?

Did you enjoy your holiday?

Did your father buy a new car?



Making questions

- Notice that we don't use the past form of the verb in the question but the most basic form of the verb:
 - ~~Did you saw that movie last night?~~
 - Did you **see** the movie last night?
- If you compare questions in past simple and present simple, you will notice only one difference. **What is it?**
 - Do you read books a lot?
 - Did you read books a lot in the past?

Making questions

1. Translate following questions:

- Slyšel jsi včera tu novinu?

Did you hear the news yesterday?

- Poznali oni své nejlepší přátele ve škole?

Did they meet their best friends at primary school?

- Měl jsi včera čas?

Did you have time yesterday?

- Byli oni loni na dovolené?

Were they on holiday last year?

- Napsal jsi včera večer nějaký e-mail?

Did you write any e-mail last night?



Making questions

- We can also add „wh- words“ (what, why, where, when, who etc.) to the beginning of a question. Compare:
 - A: „*Did you study yesterday?*“ B: „*Yes, I did.*“
 - A: „**Where** *did you study?*“ B: „*In my room.*“

2. Answer following questions, work in pairs:

- Where were you born?
- When did you last drink water?
- Who did you watch TV with yesterday?
- What did you give your parents for last Christmas?



Making questions

3. Ask your partner about these topics:

example: *you / sleep / enough / last night:*
Did you sleep enough last night?

- When / you / see / last / a movie ?
- When / your parents / last / buy / a present ?
- You / read / book / last month ?
- Visit / grandmother / last weekend ?
- What / you / last / eat ?
- Your parents / study / at university ?
- Where / you / last / go / on holiday ?
