

Common words are: for (5 years), since (I was young; yesterday), always

- I have lived in this street for 10 years already.
- She hasn't answered me since yesterday.
- Have they been married for 5 years or more?




1. Take a look at these sentences. What is the diference?

We have been married for 5 years.


We still love each other and actually we have already had two kids for 3 years.
